**Airport transfers**

*Transport from the airport*

Taxis (13 22 27) are available at all times of the day from the front of the terminal at the airport. An average fare from the airport into the city costs \$25-\$30, depending on day and time of travel. Alternatively the 'Airliner' Shuttle Bus service operates Monday to Friday, approximately every 30 minutes (Monday to Friday) and every hour (Saturday and Sunday) between the Canberra Airport and the City bus interchange. The bus departs from the shuttle bus stop outside the airport terminal. A one-way fare costs \$9 or a return is \$15. Expected travel time is approximately 25 minutes (however this can be significantly longer in peak times). *Transport back to the airport*
